

Appliances that have the rescaled energy label



Smaller appliances (e.g. a smaller sized TV) will use less energy overall than a larger model but may have a lower energy rating. Therefore, make sure you use the energy labels to compare energy consumption.



Low consumption could also be achieved by operating the appliance correctly.



Don't forget to recycle the product properly at the end of its life.
